Consumer Price Index July 2024

Consumer Price Index: All Groups CPI, July 2024.

Puntland basket of consumer goods and services sample contains 12 categories based on the standard classification of individual consumption by purpose. These 12 categories consist of 387 individual items of goods and services and the price per item is collected from the markets of all the major cities in Puntland on weekly basis.

The All-Groups CPI decreased from 103.72 to 103.42 in July 2024. The monthly change of July 2024 was decrease of -0.30 percent compared to an increase of 0.15 percent in the previous month of June 2024. The most significant monthly price decrease was in Miscellaneous Goods & Services (-2.47%), Food & Beverages (-1.29%), Clothing & Footwear (-0.43%), Tobacco & khat (-0.37%) and Recreation & Culture (-0.22%). These positive movements led to price development at All-Groups of CPI level.




Figure 1: All Groups CPI - Combination inflation rate and index graph.

The annual change (or inflation rate), over the twelve months to July 2024 was decrease of -0.04 percent. This change is compared to an increase of 0.35 percent over the twelve months to June 2024. The most significant price decrease were Food & Beverages (-0.96%), Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas (-0.86%), Transport (-0.78%), Clothing & Footwear (-0.11%). In general, there has been a well-grounded positive price development.

Consumer Price Index: Selected Groups in July 2024.

Food & Beverages and Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas, and Other Fuels are currently the most significant items in the consumer basket regarding household expenditure and therefore have the largest weighted influence on the All-Groups CPI.


Food & Beverages experienced a monthly decrease of -1.29 percent in July 2024 Compared to a price decrease of -0.12 percent recorded in June 2024. Year-on-year inflation decreased by -0.96 percent in July 2024, this change is compared to the year-on-year inflation of 0.70 percent increase experienced in June 2024.

Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas, and Other Fuels experienced a monthly increase of 1.67 percent in July 2024 compared to a price decrease of -0.71 percent recorded in June 2024. The year-on-year inflation rate decreased to -0.86 percent in July 2024, this change is compared to year-on-year inflation decreased to -2.02 percent experienced in June 2024.


Figure 2: All Groups CPI comparison with selected groups.

Major contributors (Negative).


- **Miscellaneous Goods & Services** prices decreased by (-2.47%) in July 2024 compared to price of (4.01%) recorded in June 2024. This decrease was mainly attributed to personal care (-4.47%).
- **Food & Beverages** prices decreased by (-1.29%) in July 2024 compared to price of (-0.12%) recorded in June 2024. This decrease was mainly attributed to food -1.34%).
- Clothing & Footwear prices decreased by (-0.43%) in July 2024 compared to a price of (0.69%) recorded in June 2024. This decrease was mainly attributed to clothing (-0.51%).
- **Tobacco & khat** prices decreased by (-0.37%) in July 2024 compared to price of (2.34%) recorded in June 2024. This decrease was mainly attributed to Tobacco (-0.36%).
- **Recreation & Culture** prices decreased by (-0.22%) in July 2024 compared to a price of (0.57%) in June 2024. This decrease was mainly attributed to Audio-visual, photographic, and information-processing equipment (-0.36%).

Major contributors (Positive).

• Housing, water, electricity, gas and other fuels prices increased by (1.67%) in July 2024 compared to a price of (-0.71%) in June 2024. This increase was mainly attributed to Maintenance and repair of the dwelling (1.13%) and electricity, gas and other fuels (3.41%).

Major contributors (Negative).

- Housing, water, electricity, gas and other fuels sector showed an annual price development of (-0.86%) for the year ending July 2024 compared to decrease of (-2.02%) recorded for the year ending June 2024. This was mainly due to decrease in Maintenance and repair of the dwelling (-1.90%) and electricity, gas and other fuels (-0.31%).
- **Food & Beverages** sector showed an annual price development of (-0.96%) for the year ending July 2024 compared to an increase of (0.70%) recorded for the year ending June 2024. This was mainly due to decrease in Food (-1.14%)
- **Transport** sector showed an annual price development of (-0.78%) for the year ending July 2024 compared to decrease of (-0.89%) recorded for the year ending June 2024. This was mainly due to decrease of transport services (-1.23%)
- Clothing & Footwear sector showed an annual price development of (-0.11%) for the year ending July 2024 compared to increase of (0.98%) recorded for the year ending June 2024. This was mainly due to decrease of clothing (-1.37%).

Major contributors (positive).

- **Restaurant & Hotels** category showed an annual price development of (7.13%) for the year ending in July 2024 compared to an increase of (4.06%) recorded for the year ending June 2024. This was mainly due to catering services (7.20%).
- **Miscellaneous goods and services** category showed an annual price development of (2.88%) for the year ending in July 2024 compared to an increase of (4.01%) recorded for the year ending June 2024. This was mainly due to an increase in personal care (1.51%).
- **Recreation & Culture** category showed an annual price development of (2.64%) for the year ending in July 2024 compared to an increase of (2.52%) recorded for the year ending June 2024. This was mainly due to Newspapers, books and stationery (6.79%).


