Consumer Price Index January 2024

Consumer Price Index: All Groups CPI, January 2024.

Puntland basket of consumer goods and services sample contains 12 categories based on the standard classification of individual consumption by purpose. These 12 categories consist of 387 individual items of goods and services and the price per item is collected from the markets of all the major cities in Puntland on weekly basis.

The All-Groups CPI increased from 104.29 to 104.34 in January 2024. The monthly change of January 2024 was an increase of 0.05 percent compared to increase of 0.34 percent in the previous month of December 2023. The most significant monthly price increase was in Recreation & Culture (1.00%), Housing, Water, Electricity and Gas (0.38%), Health (0.11%), Furnishing, Households and Maintenance (0.06%). These positive movements led to price development at All-Groups of CPI level.




Figure 1: All Groups CPI - Combination inflation rate and index graph.

The annual change (or inflation rate), over the twelve months to January 2024 was an increase of 1.52 percent. This change is compared to an increase of 0.97 percent over the twelve months to the month of December 2023. The most significant price increases were Clothing & Footwear (3.21%), Miscellaneous Goods & Services (2.85%), Furnishing, Households and Maintenance (2.38%), Food & Beverages (2.13%) and Education (1.71%). In general, there has been a well-grounded positive price development.

Consumer Price Index: Selected Groups in January 2024.

Food & Beverages and Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas, and Other Fuels are currently the most significant items in the consumer basket in terms of household expenditure and therefore have the largest weighted influence on the All-Groups CPI.


Food & Beverages experienced a monthly decrease of -0.11 percent in January 2024 Compared to price increase of 0.76 percent recorded in December 2023. Year-on-year inflation increased by 2.13 percent in January 2024, this change is compared to the year-on-year inflation of 1.80 percent increase experienced in December 2023.

Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas, and Other Fuels experienced a monthly increase of 0.38 percent in January 2024 compared to price decrease of -0.48 percent recorded in December 2023. The year-on-year inflation rate increased to 0.33 percent in January 2024, this change is compared to year-on-year inflation decreased to -1.22 percent experienced in December 2023.


Figure 2: All Groups CPI comparison with selected groups.

Major contributors (Positive).


- **Recreation & Culture** prices increased by (1.00%) in January 2024 compared to price of -0.26 percent recorded in December 2023, this increase was mainly attributed to Newspapers, books and stationery (2.71%).
- Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas prices increased by (0.38%) in January 2024 to price of -0.48 percent recorded in December 2023, this increase was mainly attributed to water supply and miscellaneous services relating to the dwelling (1.51%).
- **Health** prices increased by (0.11%) in January 2024 to price of (0.00%) percent recorded in December 2023, this increase was mainly attributed to medical products, appliances and equipment (0.25%).
- **Furnishing, Households and Maintenance** prices increased by (0.06%) in January 2024 to price increase of (0.39%) in December 2023, this increase was mainly attributed to household textiles (0.49%)

Major contributors (Negative).

• Miscellaneous Goods & Services prices decreased by (-0.15%) in January 2024 compared to price increase of (0.11%) recorded in December 2023. This decrease was mainly attributed to personal effects (-1.11%).

Major contributors (positive).

- Clothing & Footwear showed an annual price development of (3.21%) for the year ending January 2024 compared to an increase of (3.23%) recorded for the year ending December 2023. This was mainly due to an increase in clothing (3.17%) and footwear (3.36%).
- **Miscellaneous Goods & Services** category showed an annual price development of (2.85%) for the year ending to January 2024 compared to an increase of (2.99%) recorded for the year ending December 2023. This was mainly due to an increase in personal care (3.85%).
- Furnishings, household equipment and routine maintenance of the house showed an annual price development of (2.38%) for the year ending January 2023 compared to an increase of (1.53%) recorded for the year ending December 2023. This was mainly due to an increase in household textiles (4.52%) and glassware, tableware and household utensils (9.52%).
- Education showed an annual price development of (1.71%) for the year ending January 2023 compared to an increase of (1.71%) recorded for the year ending December 2023. This was mainly due to an increase in secondary education (3.23%) and tertiary education (1.89%)
- Food & non-alcoholic Beverage's sector showed an annual price development of (2.13%) for the year ending January 2024 compared to increase of (1.80%) recorded for the year ending December 2023. This was mainly due to an increase in food (2.07%) and beverages (3.54%).




Figure 5: Point contribution (weighted %) by COICOP Group to the All-Groups CPI; January 2024.

Figure 5 provides an additional analysis of the All-Groups CPI inflation result. The All-Groups movement is broken up into a cross-section of COICOP Groups displaying their respective impact (contribution) to the All,
